<p><b>APPOINTMENTS</b></p> <p><b>During your first consultation, we will assess and give you a full picture of your dental health and fitness. This is likely to take up to 45 minutes.</b> It includes a preliminary discussion, taking of medical history, jaw joint check, oral cancer screen and digital x-rays.</p>	<b>Private Fee</b>

<b>Dental Check-up, typically every 9 months.</b> Nine point check of the health of your mouth and surrounding areas with discussions of the findings.	<b>£46</b>
<b>Hygienist appointment, for plaque control - the key to your dental health.</b> Assessment of dental hygiene, thorough clean of teeth and gum margins, and advice on how to improve homecare routine.	<b>£47</b>
<b>Appointments for children with a dentist, therapist or hygienist.</b>	<b>£33/£24</b>
<p><b>STANDARD TREATMENTS</b></p> <p><b>Our fees are based on the complexity of the treatment and the materials you choose.</b> We will provide you with an estimate of the cost before treatment begins.</p>	
<b>White fillings, made of composite for durability and a natural appearance.</b>	<b>£60-£160</b>
<b>Silver amalgam fillings, the traditional type of filling material, highly durable and versatile.</b>	<b>£50-£120</b>
<b>Root canal treatment. A complex but worthwhile treatment. Requires two appointments.</b> An infected tooth can usually be saved by having the central pulp space cleaned and filled. The root-treated tooth may need a crown for additional strength.	<b>£280 Front Tooth*</b> <b>£380 Premolar*</b> <b>£480 Molar*</b>

<p><b>REPLACING A MISSING TOOTH OR TEETH</b></p> <p><b>The varied prices reflect the intricacy of the work and do not indicate that one treatment is 'better' than another. What works for one person may not be the best for you but we will guide you in your decision making process to arrive at the most appropriate solution. Leaflets explaining the detail of specific treatments are available in the waiting room.</b></p>	
<b>Implant and crown.</b> Fixed directly into the jaw, without affecting neighbouring teeth. This takes two visits, which are three months apart.	<b>£2100</b>
<b>Adhesive/Maryland Bridge.</b> Permanently glued to the neighbouring tooth or teeth.	<b>£580</b>
<b>Removable Bridge</b> (Or chrome partial denture). Clips on to your natural teeth and is removed for your daily hygiene routine. This may be ideal where gaps outnumber your teeth or if your teeth are mobile.	<b>£680</b>
<b>Fixed Bridge.</b> Requires extensive preparation of the neighbouring teeth but is very robust and permanent (e.g. 3-tooth bridge £1698)	<b>£566 per tooth*</b>
<b>Acrylic partial denture.</b> A removable, versatile, low cost option.	<b>£290</b>
<b>Complete denture.</b> These can be excellent if well designed - a great solution if your remaining teeth are very mobile. Can be secured with fixative or implants	<b>Single £490</b> <b>Set £850</b>

<b>Quick Straight Teeth.</b> Fixed braces for mild to moderate cases. Clear, less visible and comfortable.	<b>From £2400</b>

<p><b>TERMS AND CONDITIONS</b></p> <p><b>Cancellations and missed appointments.</b> We don't normally charge for cancellations but would appreciate as much notice as possible. Cancelling a day in advance will allow us to re-allocate the appointment to another person. Missed appointments will be charged for, so please tell the receptionist if you would like us to phone you prior to your appointment.</p> <p><b>Spreading payments.</b> We usually ask for payment at the end of each appointment and we accept credit and debit cards, cash and cheques. For larger treatment plans, you can set up a standing order; subject to a minimum of £100 per month.</p>
