<h2>APPOINTMENTS</h2> <p><b>During your first consultation, we will assess and give you a full picture of your dental health and fitness. This is likely to take up to 45 minutes.</b> It includes a preliminary discussion, taking of medical history, jaw joint check, oral cancer screen and digital x-rays.</p>		<p><b>Private Fee</b></p> <p><b>£80</b> *Or why not join our plan? <p><b>Dental Health Check, typically every 12 months.</b> Nine point check of the health of your mouth and surrounding areas with discussions of the findings. Any small x-rays are included.</p>		<b>£49</b>
<p><b>Hygienist appointment, for plaque control - the key to your dental health.</b> Assessment of dental hygiene, thorough clean of teeth and gum margins, and advice on how to improve homecare routine.</p>		<b>£51</b>

<h2>STANDARD TREATMENTS</h2> <p><b>The amount you pay is based on the complexity of any treatment, together with the materials you choose.</b> You will receive an estimate before any treatment begins.</p>		
<p><b>White fillings, made of composite for durability and a natural appearance.</b></p>		<b>£60-£160</b>
<p><b>Silver amalgam fillings, the traditional type of filling material, highly durable and versatile.</b></p>		<b>£50-£120</b>
<p><b>Root canal treatment. A complex but worthwhile treatment. Requires two appointments.</b> An infected tooth can usually be saved by having the central pulp space cleaned and filled. The root-treated tooth may need a crown for additional strength.</p>		<b>£290 Front Tooth* £390 Premolar* £495 Molar*</b>

<h2>REPLACING A MISSING TOOTH OR TEETH</h2> <p><b>The varied prices reflect the intricacy of the work and don't indicate that one treatment is 'better' than another. What works for one person may not be the best for you. We will guide you in your decision making process to arrive at the most appropriate solution. Leaflets explaining the detail of specific treatments are available in reception.</b></p>		
<p><b>Implant and crown. FREE Consultation.</b> Standard cases - implants placed by John Muirhead. All other cases placed by our expert, Richard Anderson.</p>		<b>£2100 £2450</b>
<p><b>Adhesive/Maryland Bridge.</b> Permanently glued to the neighbouring tooth or teeth.</p>		<b>From £580</b>
<p><b>Metal partial denture.</b> (Or chrome partial denture). Clips on to your natural teeth and is removed for your daily hygiene routine. This may be ideal where gaps outnumber your teeth or if your teeth are mobile.</p>		<b>From £695</b>
<p><b>Fixed Bridge.</b> Requires extensive preparation of the neighbouring teeth but is very robust and permanent (e.g. 3-tooth bridge £1698)</p>		<b>£566 per tooth*</b>
<p><b>Acrylic partial denture.</b> A removable, versatile, low cost option.</p>		<b>From £290</b>
<p><b>Complete denture.</b> These can be excellent if well designed - a great solution if your remaining teeth are very mobile. Can be secured with fixative or implants. Martin Page (Dip Clin Dent Tech RCS Eng) brings a new level of expertise for improved function and appearance.</p>		<b>Single £700 Set £1310</b>

<p><b>Tooth Whitening.</b> You'll receive whitening gel and your custom-made soft plastic trays for home use. These can be worn for one hour a day, over two to three weeks (then re-used in years to come, as needed).</p>		<b>£195</b>
<h2>CEREC (Ceramic Reconstruction)</h2> <p><b>The most healthy choice for a large cavity. Uses digital imaging and precision milling of colour-matched ceramic. Custom-made by the dentist.</b></p> <p>• Biocompatible • Beautiful • Accurate • Durable • Anatomically Correct • Single Visit.</p>		
<p><b>Ceramic Filling</b></p>		<b>£250-£500*</b>
<p><b>Crown / Veneer</b> (For multiple Cerecs at one visit, please deduct £50 per restoration)</p>		<b>£590*</b>
<h2>ADVANCED GUM TREATMENTS</h2>		
<p><b>Restore health to failing teeth and gums.</b> Expert care with Jan Wulf, who usually requires three to four hours, (spread over four appointments) to help you achieve outstanding results.</p>		<b>£700-£800</b>
<h2>PROTECTING YOUR TEETH</h2>		
<p><b>Mouth Guard.</b> We can usually supply a mouth-guard for contact sports in twenty-four hours. Don't play without one!</p>		<b>£50</b>
<p><b>Night Guard.</b> For night-time grinders.</p>		<b>£50</b>
<p><b>Snore Guard.</b> The way to a sound night's sleep - for both of you!</p>		<b>£180</b>
<p><b>Splint (CRA).</b> Treatment for some specific types of head and neck pain.</p>		<b>£475</b>
<h2>URGENT CARE</h2>		
<p><b>Registered patients.</b> Please phone after 8.30am. Out-of-hours call-out.</p>		<b>Treatment costs only £60 plus treatment costs</b>
<p><b>If you have lapsed or are not registered with Muirhead Dental Health.</b> Appointment during opening hours. Out-of-hours call-out.</p>		<b>£49 plus treatment costs £140 plus treatment costs</b>
<h2>CHILDREN</h2> <p>From 0 to 20 years of age, check-ups and hygiene appointments cost £25. When a space becomes available, our NHS contract allows us to register children for free dental care up to their 18th birthday.</p>		
<h2>TERMS AND CONDITIONS</h2>		
<p><b>Cancellations and missed appointments.</b> We don't usually charge for cancellations but would appreciate as much notice as possible. Cancelling a day in advance will allow us to re-allocate your appointment to another person. Missed appointments will be charged for.</p>		
<p><b>Spreading payments.</b> We expect payment at the end of each appointment and we accept credit and debit cards, cash and cheques. For larger treatment plans, you can set up a standing order, subject to a minimum of £100 per month and a maximum of ten payments.</p>
